

# Elite East Show & Sale - Entry Form, Requirements & Rules

## General Information

Entry fees for all entries must accompany the respective entry form. Entry fees will be as follows; Entries postmarked or delivered to Farmers Cooperative in Frederick, Maryland by April 6, 2007—fees will be \$15 per entry animal. Entries postmarked or delivered to Farmers Cooperative in Frederick, Maryland after April 6, 2007 (including day of show & sale)—\$20 per entry animal. Animals will not be accepted at sale without entry form and fee on file or in hand. All entry fees are non-refundable. Entry fees may be paid by cash, check or credit card. **DO NOT MAIL CASH.** Entry fee will cover all expenses associated with sale, including auctioneer.

All pig entries must be checked-in by 10:00am on the day of the Show, **Saturday, April 28th**. All pigs selected for the respective sales (female and male) must be offered for sale. Prior to the show, there will be a sift. Sifted/non-selected pigs must be removed from the arena and will not be shown or sold.

The Elite East Show & Sale, by way of Farmers Cooperative Association, Inc., will be responsible for obtaining buyers for pigs being shown at this event. ## Rules

- A. NO CLIPPING
- B. Same health requirements as breeding stock.
- C. Should be born between January 1, 2007—March 31, 2007.
- D. All purebred pigs that show in the purebred class must have a pedigree that accompanies each entry.
- E. Entries are open to all eight breeds and all crossbreds. Classes will be divided by breed, sex, and age.
- F. There is no limit to pigs (barrows, boars or gilts) per exhibitor.
- G. Pig entries WILL be accepted at the show, at the late rate of \$20 per entry animal.
- H. Castrated males must be completely healed.

## Health Regulations

All animals entering the Frederick County Fairgrounds must meet these health regulations:

1. All Maryland swine entries must be accompanied by the 2007 Intrastate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) for show.
2. All out of state livestock entries must be accompanied by an official transport copy of an interstate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. The interstate (CVI) is only valid for 30 days from the date of issuance.
3. Each animal must be identified.
4. All animals will be inspected for general health upon presentation. Those showing clinical signs of ANY contagious or infectious disease must be removed from the Show, and Fairgrounds. In such cases the health certificate may be modified, suspended or revoked.
5. The 2007 Intrastate CVI for Maryland exhibitors must be filled out, completed and signed by an accredited veterinarian within 45 days of the first MD exhibition.
6. Approval of all entries for the first showing in Maryland will extend in 60 day increments through the show season, providing that the status of the herd or animal(s) does not change. The Intrastate CVI must be signed and dated on the reverse side by a MDA Animal Health Official at each event to extend the 60 day effective date. An alternative method for extending the CVI approval period is to have your veterinarian recertify the health status and record on the back of the CVI.
7. Where immunization is recommended or required it must be done in conformity with standard procedures and practices consistent with the development of immunity PRIOR to entering Fairgrounds.
8. All swine must be individually identified by ear tag, tattoo, or registration number.
9. It is recommended that all animals be vaccinated for Leptospirosis.
