Ingredients

Dehulled Soybean Meal, Monocalcium Phosphate, Dicalcium Phosphate, Calcium Carbonate, Magnesium Oxide, Magnesium Sulfate, Potassium Sulfate, Ground Corn, Brewers Dried Yeast (*Saccharomyces Cerevisiae*), Animal Fat, BHT (A Preservative), Vitamin A Supplement, Vitamin D₃ Supplement, Vitamin E Supplement, Menadione Sodium Bisulfite Complex, Riboflavin Supplement, Niacin, d-Calcium Pantothenate, Thiamine Mononitrate, Vitamin B₁₂ Supplement, Biotin, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Folic Acid, Iron Oxide, Sodium Selenite, Choline Chloride, Zinc Oxide, Rice Hulls, Amorphous Silicon Dioxide, Citric Acid, Soybean Oil, Ethoxyquin - Butylated Hydroxytoluene - Phosphoric Acid - Butylated Hydroxyanisole - Propionic Acid (Preservatives), Vegetable Mono- and Diglycerides, Manganous Oxide, Ferrous Sulfate, Cobalt Carbonate, Potassium Iodide.



Feeding Directions

MoorMan's ShowTec #1 Mineral Supplement is a protein fortified mineral supplement for all species of ruminating show livestock. Top-dress rations for goats or lambs with ShowTec #1 Mineral Supplement at a rate of 2 oz per 100 lb of body weight per head per day, with a minimum consumption of 2 oz per head per day. Top-dress rations for calves with ShowTec #1 Mineral Supplement at a rate of 1 oz per 100 lb of body weight per head per day. ShowTec #1 Mineral Supplement should be fed during the entire feeding period to provide essential vitamins and minerals for maintenance and growth. ShowTec #1 Mineral Supplement should be fed free-choice to young nursing ruminant livestock in creep areas until weaning.

Per Day Feeding Examples:

40-100 lb Goats	2 oz	ShowTec Elite Goat DC fed at 3% of body weight
50-100 lb Lambs	2 oz*	ShowTec 15.5 Lamb DC fed at 3% of body weight
450-1200 lb Cattle	4.5 to 12 oz	ShowTec Cattle Grower BT fed at 2.5% of body weight

110-lb Goat	2.2 oz	3.3 lb ShowTec Elite Goat DC
150-lb Lamb	3 oz*	4.5 lb ShowTec 15.5 Lamb DC
800-lb Calf	8 oz	20 lb ShowTec Cattle Grower BT

*Do not exceed recommended feeding rate for lambs in order to avoid copper toxicity

NOTE: Always provide clean, fresh water to livestock at all times. Livestock should be kept parasite free and current on all vaccinations and/or medications recommended by a veterinarian.

CAUTION: Follow label directions. Feeding selenium at levels in excess of 0.3 ppm in the total diet is prohibited.
