INGREDIENT STATEMENT

Ground Corn, Soybean Meal, Alfalfa Meal, Dried Corn Distillers Grains, Corn Gluten Meal, Ground Barley, Soybean Oil, Calcium Carbonate, Monocalcium Phosphate, Cane Molasses, Lactobacillus acidophilus Fermentation Product Dehydrated, Lactobacillus casei Fermentation Product Dehydrated, Bifido bacterium Bifidum Fermentation Product Dehydrated, Enterococcus Faecium Fermentation Product Dehydrated, Zinc Sulfate, Manganese Sulfate, Mineral Oil, Copper Sulfate, Calcium Pantothenate, Brewers Liquid Yeast (Saccharomyces Cerevisiae), Riboflavin Supplement, Vitamin B12 Supplement, Folic Acid Supplement, Vitamin A Acetate, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Cholicalciferol (Source of Vitamin D3), Calcium Iodate, Thiamine Mononitrate, Menadione Nicotinamide Bisulfite, Ground Limestone, dl-Alpha-Tocopheryl Acetate (Source of Vitamin E), Salt, L-Lysine, dl-Methionine, Lignin Sulfonate, Sodium Bicarbonate, Niacin, Biotin, Sodium Selenite, Potassium Magnesium Sulfate, Propionic Acid (a preservative), Acetic Acid. Benzoic Acid (a preservative).

FFFDING DIRECTIONS

Feed to Emu as a sole ration. Feed FCA Emu Breeder 3 to 4 weeks before onset of egg production and continue feeding Emu Breeder throughout the laying season. Following laying season, Emus should be fed FCA Emu Finisher. When feeding ratites, offer only enough feed as will be consumed in one day. If excess feed remains, reduce feed the following day. If all feed is consumed, increase feed for the following day. Forcing the birds to "clean up" the feed on a daily basis results in birds consuming a more balanced diet. Proper feed management can go a long way to increasing feed to bird nutrition and efficiency. Have plenty of clean drinking water available at all times.
