Crimped Oats, Flaked Corn, Crimped Barley, Cane Molasses, Cottonseed Hull Pellets, Calcium Carbonate, Tallow, BHT (A Preservative), Soybean Oil, Soybean Meal, Corn Gluten Meal, Dried Distillers Grains, Wheat Middings, Salt, Urea, Magnesium Oxide, Ferrous Sulfate, Cobalt Carbonate, Copper Sulfate, Calcium Iodate, Manganous Oxide, Brewers Liquid Yeast (Saccharomyces Cerevisiae), Manganese Sulfate, Zinc Oxide, Zinc Sulfate, Calcium Sulfate, Sodium Selenite, Extracted Citric Acid Presscake, Sodium Propionate (A Preservative), Vitamin E Supplement, Silicon Dioxide, Vegetable Oil, Citric Acid-Ethoxyquin-BHA (Preservatives), Potassium Magnesium Sulfate, Vegetable Mono- and Diglycerides, Vitamin A Supplement, Vitamin D3 Supplement, Choline Chloride, Biotin, Niacin Supplement, Thiamine Mononitrate, Propionic Acid (a preservative), Acetic Acid, Benzoic Acid (a preservative), Phosphoric Acid, Natural and Artificial Flavors.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed 2.5 lb per 100 lb of body weight per day to cattle weighing 500-1000 lbs to provide between 143.75 and 287.5 mg Lasalocid/hd/day. For peak performance top-dress ShowTec #1 Mineral Supplement daily at a rate of 1 oz per 100 lbs body weight. We recommend all show calves be fed a small amount of good quality hay at a rate of 4 to 8 lb per head per day. Provide clean, fresh drinking water at all times. Feed salt, free-choice or species specific mineral.

WARNING

A withdrawal period has not been established for pre-ruminating cattle. Do not use in calves to be processed for veal.

CAUTION

The safety of Lasalocid for use in unapproved species has not been established. Do not allow horses or other equines access to feeds containing Lasalocid as ingestion may be fatal. Mix thoroughly with grain and/or roughage prior to feeding. Feeding undiluted or mixing errors may result in an excess Lasalocid concentration that could be fatal to cattle and sheep.
